


Number of I-526 Petitions Filed by Taiwanese EB-5 Investors (FY2009 - FY2018*)

Investors from Taiwan contributed more than \$120 million in capital investment through the EB-5 Program in FY2018.


Taiwan is a matured and stable EB-5 investor market with the potential to grow. In FY2018, the estimated amount of EB-5 capital investment from the Taiwanese market continued to increase to \$121 million, reaching to its alltime-high since the inception of the EB-5 Program in 1990.

Nearly 270 Taiwanese investors applied for the EB-5 Program in Fiscal Year (FY) 2018, a growth of 48% year-over-year.


IIUSA estimated that approximately 269 EB-5 investors from Taiwan filed their I-526 petition in FY2018 (October 1st, 2017 - September 30th, 2018).

With a 48% year-over-year increase in I-526 filing, Vietnam accounted for nearly 7% of the market shares of the total EB-5 applications (in terms of I-526 filings) among all countries other than China in FY2018.

Average I-526 Approval Rates by Top EB-5 Investor Markets (FY2016 & FY2017)



Taiwanese EB-5 investors saw an average approval rate of 92% in FY2017.

According to U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS), the average approval rate of EB-5 petitions (Form I-526) for Taiwanese investors was 92% in FY2017, above the average approval rate among the largest EB-5 investor markets.
