Buffalo, NY

 **Job Creation Estimate: 2,380**

 **EB-5 Investment: \$50M**

The EB-5 Program played a crucial role in funding the development of the John R. Oishei Children's Hospital in Buffalo, creating thousands of local jobs for the residents of western New York. The new hospital was named as one of the top children's hospitals in the country.

JEFFERSON ENERGY TERMINAL

Vidor, TX

 **Job Creation Estimate: 1,500**

 **EB-5 Investment: \$31.5M**

EB-5 financing was used for the development of Jefferson Energy Terminal at the Port of Beaumont. Not only has this infrastructure project brought jobs to the local area, it also serves as an essential component in the supply chain for some of North America's largest oil producers and refineries.

 **Job Creation Estimate: 5,368**

 **EB-5 Investment: \$800M**

EB-5 funding supported this infrastructure project that rebuilt sections of the Pennsylvania Turnpike, constructing new interchanges and widening existing highways. The upgraded infrastructure improved safety and provides a more efficient flow of traffic for Turnpike travelers.

South Florida

 **Job Creation Estimate: 7,920**

 **EB-5 Investment: \$350M**

EB-5 funding helped finance the development and operation of a 67-mile track from Miami to West Palm Beach with stations in Miami, Fort Lauderdale, and West Palm Beach. This transformative infrastructure project is the first high-speed passenger rail system in Florida.

BIG RIVER STEEL MANUFACTURE

Osceola, AR

 **Job Creation Estimate: 13,160**

 **EB-5 Investment: \$160M**

EB-5 investment supported a multiple-phase expansion of Big River Steel, one of the biggest economic development projects in Arkansas history and one of the most technologically advanced advanced scrap recycling steel production facility in the world.

 **EB-5 Investment: \$36.5M**

EB-5 investment supported a major expansion of Crocker Park in Westlake, OH. In addition to adding retail, residential and other amenities, this project also developed the new global headquarter for American Greetings Corporation and attracted jobs to the local community.
