→ **WHAT IS THE IIUSA PAC?**

The IIUSA Political Action Committee (IIUSA PAC) is a critical advocacy tool that helps the association support federal candidates who the association believes espouse its values including extending or making permanent the EB-5 Regional Center Program, expanding visa capacity, improving adjudication times and consistency, supporting program integrity, and more.

→ **WHO CAN PARTICIPATE IN THE IIUSA PAC?**

Making financial contributions or “participating in” the IIUSA PAC is limited to employees of IIUSA member organizations. Employees’ spouses are also permitted to contribute. However, only U.S. citizens or permanent residents can contribute to any PAC including the IIUSA PAC.

Contributing to the IIUSA PAC is NOT a requirement of IIUSA membership.

→ **HOW MUCH CAN I CONTRIBUTE TO THE IIUSA PAC?**

There is no minimum amount one must contribute, however, there is an annual maximum of \$5,000 per qualified contributor.

→ **HOW ARE IIUSA PAC FUNDS USED OR DISTRIBUTED?**

The IIUSA PAC Board, in consultation with IIUSA’s government affairs team, makes decisions about which candidates to support and how much money the IIUSA PAC gives to their campaigns. The IIUSA PAC is bipartisan, making contributions to both Democratic and Republican candidates who support the EB-5 industry and IIUSA priorities like extending or making permanent the EB-5 Regional Center Program, expanding visa capacity, improving adjudication times and consistency, and supporting program integrity.

Because the IIUSA PAC is “affiliated” with IIUSA, the association can underwrite the PAC’s activities such as paying for an outside treasurer/accountant to manage IIUSA PAC assets and for IIUSA PAC dinners that welcome candidates as speakers. This means that 100% of any contribution to the IIUSA PAC is used to support like-minded candidates and EB-5 champions.
